



PURCHASE OF OWN SHARES

Cesena, 22 September 2015 – Pursuant to the resolution passed at the Shareholders' Meeting of 30th April 2015, TREVI - Finanziaria Industriale SpA, announces that, between September 18, 2015 and September 21, 2015, it acquired 22,600 of its own shares at an average price of 1.071 euros per share, for a total of about 24,000 euros.

Having made these purchases, TREVI - Finanziaria Industriale SpA. now holds a total of 151,000 of its own shares, equal to approximately 0.1% of its share capital.

Trevi Group is a worldwide leader in the field of soil engineering (special foundations, tunnel excavation, soil consolidation and the building and marketing of special rigs and equipment relevant to this engineering sector); the Group is also active in the drilling sector (oil, gas and water) both in the production of plant and the supply of services, and it also builds automated underground car parks. The Group was established in Cesena in 1957 and today has more than 30 branches and is present in over 80 countries. Its success is due to the vertical integration of the main divisions making up the Group: **Trevi**, the division that supplies special services in the field of soil engineering, **Petreven**, the oil drilling division of the Group, **Soilmec**, the division that produces and develops plant and machinery for soil engineering and **Drillmec** the division that produces and develops drilling rigs (oil, gas and water).

The parent company TREVI – Finanziaria Industriale Spa has been listed on the Milan stock exchange since July 1999.

The key financial figures for 2014 are: Total revenues of €1,250.7 million, EBITDA of €126.4 million (margin of 10.1%), EBIT of €62.6 million (margin of 5.0%), and NET PROFIT of €24.4 million.
